Take the train to Dartmoor with Great Western Railway

Every Sunday from 21 May to 10 September we will be running services from Exeter to the ancient market town of Okehampton.

Okehampton lies on the north edge of Dartmoor and is the perfect starting point for exploring the spectacular landscape and peaceful atmosphere of the UK's most southerly National Park.

If you wish to visit the town, Okehampton has plenty of local pubs and cafés to enjoy a meal. Okehampton Castle is also a short walk from the town centre.

With 4 trains each way on Sundays, you can enjoy up to 8 hours indulging yourself in the local area.

What can I do when I'm there?

Okehampton

The ancient market town of Okehampton has a wide variety of shops as well as a fine selection of cafés and pubs to sample. The town centre is a 10-15 minute walk from the station.

Dartmoor Railway

Change at Okehampton and hop straight over the bridge onto the Dartmoor Railway. Travel to Meldon Viaduct where a spectacular view over Dartmoor awaits you (Additional charges apply. Please check operating days at **dartmoor-railway-sa.org** before travelling).

Granite Way

If you enjoy walking or cycling, the Granite Way starts from just outside Okehampton station and offers a great chance to explore Dartmoor. Bikes can be hired from just outside the station (Up to £12 per person).

Okehampton Castle

Run by English Heritage, the ruins of Okehampton Castle are a perfect place to enjoy a riverside picnic and learn more about the history of the castle (Additional charges apply, English Heritage members go free).

Fares

An adult day return from Exeter to Okehampton costs just **£5.20** per person. Discounts for children (aged 5-15) and railcard holders are available. Under 5's travel for free.

GroupSave

Groups of 3 to 9 people travelling together can save 1/3 on the total cost with GroupSave.
