1. The minutes of the Annual Parish meeting of 2009 – no matters arising
2. Chairman's report – Cllr.Jacobs gave a report of the work of the Council over the past year – copy attached to minute file
3. Any other business – the following matters were brought to the attention of the council by members of the public present:-
 - a) Market St./Bridge St. – not kept clean throughout the year – but were clean for the Tour of Britain – council will contact WDBC.
 - b) War Memorial is dirty, broken and a disgrace to the town – council will take this matter on board
 - c) Bus service is required top of Market St. and Claremnt - council to contact bus company
 - d) Red Lane – continuing problems with leaves and blocked drains. Garden refuse has to be taken to Park Road.
 - e) Parking on pavements in town – if inconsiderable parking is causing an obstruction, then the police should be called
 - f) Allotments – question as to exact number and allocation was raised – Cllrs.Abell and Alford gave a full and comprehensive report of the allotment process from the initial stages upto the present time.

The chairman thanked those members of the public for their attendance and interest in town matters, and there being no further business closed the meeting at 7.45pm.
