**Mr.D.Greenhill:**

a) Jubilee footpath - the lower/middle section is dangerous and remedial work is urgently required.

Comments were noted and it was agreed that Cllr.Laing-Trengove would contact Mr.J.Baker, the footpath officer for DCC.

b) Moor Management Committee - he had asked the committee 6 weeks ago for a copy of the constitution and why there were three town councillors on the committee. He had heard nothing. Cllrs.Trenaman and Laing-Trengove who both sit on Moor Management reported that they only had a meeting last week and it was agreed that a copy of the constitution which was drawn up in early 1950s when the moor management was set up was to be lifted and available for any member of the public to inspect.
