Our meeting this month opened with the induction of our two new Councillors, Mr Peter Back and Mr Roger Lapthorn. We hope they have a successful and enjoyable time in office.

A new bollard has been placed outside the Coop to prevent cars blocking the path for pedestrians, wheelchair users, mobility scooters and blocking visibility at the junction. PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF IT! Our PCSO has told us that he will issue fixed charge penalty notices to offenders.

The ongoing saga of the path from the roundabout to the sports field is hopefully soon to be remedied. Devon County Council has refused to help due to their funding cuts so the Town Council is in discussions with a local company to carry out the works.

The hanging baskets are up for the summer. If you have one outside of your house could you adopt it and water it please.

The bus shelter in town is set to get a make-over in the next month or so. The painting for this will kindly be done by staff from the Co-op store as part of its renewed initiative of connecting with the community.

It has been brought to our notice again, that a member of the public is putting their rubbish next to the bin in the square, could whoever it is please use the allotted rubbish day.

The Sunday Service train running from Okehampton to Exeter this summer is proving to be a big success. On Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>August there will be a trial run of a bus running from Hatherleigh to connect to the 09.55 train at a cost of £1.50. If it proves successful there could be more buses in the future. There is further information in this Pump about this.

Patrick Kimber our West Devon Councillor reported that discussions are taking place on the possibility of a NatWest mobile Bank being in Hatherleigh on a Thursday afternoon, watch this space!
