

#### **Hatherleigh School joins the Dynamic Dunescape Project**

A few months ago, we were invited to take part in an exciting joint project with the National Trust, promoting the importance of sand dunes and raising awareness of their decline. We received a life-size cow and the theme Wilderness. After discussing the meaning of Wilderness, all the children sketched their own images for what they thought our cow should look like and these were combined into one final design. The children's designs focused mainly on dark forest areas, the space of Dartmoor and its tors and of course Devon's beaches. All the children from Reception to Year 6 had the opportunity to contribute towards painting her. She has been named 'Hawthorn Glade', the meaning of Hatherleigh which dates back to 981 and it being a Saxon Settlement. She will be joining all the other cows at Woolacombe dunes for the cow sculpture trail starting on the 25th June which is also Sand Dune Awareness Day.

The children thoroughly enjoyed painting her and were clearly excited about being part of a whole school project. **Further photos can be found on our school website**



#### **TUCKERS PLOT**

#### **Plant Nostalgia**

At Hatherleigh Market last Tuesday a lady was seemingly a bit TOO happy to find I had Red Hot Poker plants for sale. She explained that her unbridled enthusiasm was down to the fact that she now had a garden of her own to fill and above all she wanted a Red Hot Poker because it reminded her of her grandmother's garden and the happy times she had when she was a little girl playing in the garden and this lead me to think about all the plants that mean so much to me because of the people that grew them.



My lovely grandad use to always grow Sweet Peas at the front of his allotment at the bottom of the

garden and just seeing and smelling Sweet Peas makes me think of the times I'd help him (or probably hinder him!) as a little girl. We would pick some Sweet Peas and lay the bunch on top of the trug and walk up the garden with that day's goodies from the allotment. I would present the big fat bunch of flowers to grandma and she would carefully arrange them in her special Sweet Pea Bowl and then we'd sit in the garden shucking peas or stringing runner beans for dinner.

Good old French Marigolds and bright red Geraniums always remind me of my mother's garden; she had one of those gardens that people would always stop and comment on as they walked by. So much work but she just loved a garden full of bright flowers and all grown from seed.

My husband and his siblings always remember the big fat Cornish daffodils in their grandma's garden and we all now have plants in our gardens that are simply called "the Eric plant" or the "Auntie Kath plant" as, whatever the official name of the plant is, it will always be remembered by the person that gave it to us.

My plant, that has gone everywhere with me for over 30 years is the Arum Lily. Whenever I have moved a piece of the original lily has always come with me and now it's in my garden in Hatherleigh.

#### **Cheese and Spinach Parcels**

If you've got quite a lot of spinach growing already and you've got dill and mint and maybe a little oregano and parsley then why not try making SPANAKOPITA..... Greek Spinach and cheese parcels.... great for snacks and lunchboxes.

#### Ingredients:

1 x 500g block of puff pastry (you could make your own but life is REALLY is too short for that.... even during lockdown!!!)

Lots of spinach leaves as they go down to nothing when cooked..... you will probably need a small carrier bag worth

- 1 block of Feta cheese crumbled up (some people like to add a little Ricotta for a creamier texture)
- 1 medium onion (grated)
- 2 large beaten eggs (reserve some for sealing and glazing)

A big bunch of herbs... mostly dill and mint but you can also add in parsley, oregano and chives all finely chopped

Lots of black pepper & go easy on the salt as the Feta is quite salty

Big squeeze of lemon

Just a very little nutmeg

1 tbsp olive oil

Wilt the spinach, drain and squeeze all the water out.... finely chop the spinach.

Put in a bowl with all the other ingredients and mix very well together.... leave aside.... do not refrigerate.

Heat your oven to 200 degrees and olive oil a large baking tray.

Roll out your pastry (keeping a square shape) to about 1/2 a cm thick and cut into 5 inch squares (you can do smaller or larger if you want but they will take more or less time to cook).

Plonk a good dollop of the filling in the middle of each parcel... usually best to do this with your hands so you can squidge it together better. Egg the edges so they

will stick and then fold over into a triangle and fork the edges so they will stay together.

Arrange on the tray with a little gap between each, brush with egg and bake for about 25 mins.... make sure the oven is really hot and the filling is room temp or they will not puff up.

You can eat them hot or cold.





Your 10 Councillors are Clare Tyson (Chair/ Mayor), Rachel Laycock (Deputy), Deb Laing-Trengove, Claire Gladstone, Peter Back, Kay Walters, Donna Lewis, Paul Bolland, Callum Entwistle and Ellie Holland.

Hatherleigh Town Council is holding its June meeting late this month and will miss this Pumps deadline. We can though report on some items that will certainly be raised:

A meeting was held in May with West Devon Borough Council, Devon County Council and Kingswood Homes to discuss the access road from Bridge St into the new market development. This land is owned by WDBC and we were informed they had no plans to upgrade this road. Cllrs highlighted the need for improvements of safety measures for pedestrians now this was becoming a busy thoroughfare. WDBC will look at removing the roadside parking bays but have no plans for pavements and street lighting.

We raised a number of traffic safety issues around town, namely the pinch point outside the vets leading to vehicle mounting the pavement; Island Park entrance and the need for traffic claiming measures; and Moor View junction congestion and lack of pavement towards the industrial estate.

Devon County Council have responded with a detailed reply explaining why works cannot be carried out - lack of funds being a key factor. We have though requested 'Playground Ahead' warning sign.

As reported last month demolition of the remaining market building is imminent. The Tuesday market team have been busy erecting their new marquee and preparing the temporary area provided by the developers.

There has been a flurry of activity in searching/applying for grants to fund improvements to the pannier building design we wish to see to make the new building more weatherproof and versatile.

We are awaiting news from the Lottery Partnership Fund and have received help from WDBC for inclusion in their bid for the UK Community Renewal Fund. Fingers are crossed!

A Hatherleigh Future - Build Back Better meeting was organised between ourselves, Devon Communities Together, and a number of town organisations and businesses. Here we discussed progress of the council working groups and what actions we need to focus on to support the towns businesses.

On a lighter note the hanging baskets are up and people are commenting how lovely they are! Please help keep them watered.... etc etc






