A quiet man in the corner of the bar, take note the sign, in the Tally Ho!, where he sat reads "Bull Shit Corner". He even got a beer pump in the Tally Ho! In his image, Cavalier Ale, he had that regal look!

As a chess player he was a founding member of the Pub Chess league, when the Red Lion, Exbourne used to play against the Devonshire Inn of Stickelepath.

Many pub landlords will mourn his passing as their profits will tumble and their accountants warn them of appending doom.

He had a traumatic life during the time I knew him, first his son Mathew died, which neither him or his late wife Susan ever got over. Susan often lit candles in churches and cathedrals, both in the UK and Spain for Mathew. They had a "Marriage of mutual tolerance" as Barry often described it! But despite the tiffs they stuck by and looked after each other over many years and many issues.



As the sign that Susan had hanging up in the utility proclaimed "We have a stable Marriage, I work like a horse and he is as stubborn as a mule!"

Sadly, Susan was taken in by "Butterflies Mental Health" who allegedly supported her **but** her involvement with them lead to her sudden death. After which Barry then came to live with us for four months where my young granddaughter used to say "You can't sit there that's Barry's chair!"

When we travelled abroad together we took it in turns to cook, when it came to Barry's turn we all went out to eat in a local bar or restaurant.

It took a lot to get on the wrong side of Barry. I was sometimes astonished by his willingness to forgive those that had wronged him and did not hold any noticeable malice towards them

He often asked what he had done wrong to upset people right up to the end, to try and build bridges.

He had a wish that both his ashes and Susan's would be made into a diamond so they would survive together for ever!

Barry expected that Sue would outlive him as he was diagnosed with COPD, over 20 years ago and was only given 14 years to live.

His phrase "It'll all lovely in the end", I know I speak for many when I say I hope it is true for him!

"Keep ducking" was another of Barry's phrases relating the Grim Reaper. Sadly, he forgot to duck. Barry Leaves behind, daughter Hannah, Son Paul and Grandchildren Karl and Sophie.



#### **Spottersheet for August - Corvid Confusion:**

Crows, Jackdaws, Rooks and Ravens are difficult to distinguish between them. Magpies and Jays are also included in the corvid family but they are more easy to spot with their distinctive plumage.



Crows tend to be seen in pairs or are solitary birds. They walk or hop on the ground. They feed off carrion, insects, worms, seeds, fruit, eggs and any scraps.

#### Appearance:

The adult Crows have black eyes & plumage with a light violet gloss on their body & greenish-blue gloss on their wings. Juveniles have pale blue eyes and duller, more brown plumage.

#### **Interesting Fact:**

An extremely intelligent bird with the largest brain of all birds except for Parrots. Some have been observed using basic tools and even sliding down a snow covered roof using a jar lid as a sledge!



Jackdaws have been seen flying over Hatherleigh in big groups but not in numbers that are a concern.

They like open woodlands and old buildings. They feed off insects, fruit, seeds and scraps, they are opportunists and may occasionally take a young bird.

#### Appearance:

Allover black with a sheen of grey on the head and at the base of the wings.

#### Interesting Fact:

These small corvids are highly intelligent and social. Once a tame Jackdaw was trained to steal money from cash machines but it's more common to see them working out how to gain access to bird feeders!

#### Rook



They are normally observed in flocks.

Occasionally gliding, often in loose,
straggling flocks. They eat
earthworms,insect larvae, grain, nuts,
small mammals, birds (especially eggs and
nestlings) and carrion.

#### Appearance:

A similar size to the crow with black feathers with bluish-purple sheen. Head and neck feathers are dense and silky, with black legs and feet, the bill is grey-black. Wings are broad with deeply slotted tips.

#### **Interesting Fact:**

Like other members of the corvid family, Rooks are intelligent and have demonstrated the ability to use tools and solve problems.



Their natural habitat is woodland and farmland but can be seen visiting gardens.

Often seen (or heard) flying over Hatherleigh Moor. They are usually solitary. They feed off carrion, mammals, birds and eggs, insects and other invertebrates.

#### Appearance:

The biggest of the Corvids. It is all black with a large bill, and long wings. In flight, it shows a diamond-shaped tail.

#### **Interesting Fact:**

Ravens are as intelligent as dolphins.

Ravens point with their beaks to indicate an object to another bird. They have been observed to show empathy for fellow ravens by consoling them if they have lost a fight.

Notes from the Council Meetings held on Tuesday 22nd June and Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

Your 10 Councillors are Clare Tyson (Chair/ Mayor), Rachel Laycock (deputy), Deb Laing-Trengove, Claire Gladstone, Peter Back, Kay Walters, Donna Lewis, Paul Bolland, Callum Entwistle and Ellie Holland.

Mr John Hall attended the public session. He proposed a scheme whereby customers of the Co-op would have their parking refunded if they spend over £10 in store. He felt this might help control the illegal parking outside the store. He has now had responses from both Co-op Area Manager and West Devon Council and has arranged a meeting with both parties. It was agreed for us to send an Email of support. With thanks to Mr Hall for his efforts.

Netty Holwill attended the public session concerned with speeding issues. She has started a petition to reduce the speed limit at the top of Victoria Road which is currently 60 mph. The road is not suitable for this dangerous speed. She is organising a speed survey with the use of flashing speed signs and speed guns to monitor this. We fully support this initiative. The petition is available on site and in the Garden Shop in Town. With thanks to Netty Holwill and team.

The Zip wire in Island Park was discussed. We still await further quotes from play specialist companies but sadly the advice so far is that it may not be viable to repair or replace it. We are investigating what might be a better use of the space, should this prove to be the case.

A meeting was held with West Devon Council, Devon County Council, Kingswood Homes and ourselves to discuss the access road to the market area. This is a private road owned by West Devon, it is not of a suitable standard for adoption by Devon CC and there are no plans to upgrade it at present. Other traffic issues were raised and a further meeting was suggested in 2 months. It was agreed to request a Playground sign at the Island Park entrance to warn drivers to reduce their speed on this cut through.

The temporary Market Marquee has been erected. A big thank you to everyone who helped. The Market continues to operate successfully and this is largely due to the heroic efforts of the Market Manager Debbie Kimber. We would like to express our sincere gratitude to her. Our Lottery application was unsuccessful. We continue to look for funding to enable us to adapt the new Market building to ensure that it will be secure and suitable for many uses for the future.

The lights around the Horse sculpture in front of school are no longer working but as these were only temporary, they will be removed.

The Vick family have kindly donated the old market weighbridge scales to be reinstated in the new pannier building as a reminder of the Town's agricultural history. This is now stored at Hole Court.

The Royal British Legion have kindly offered to site a "Lest We Forget" bench in the Town.

Devon County Council agreed to adopt the Sportsfield footpath as a public right of way and this has now been formalised.

The Jubilee footpath work has now been completed and looks very smart.

The drains around Town were cleared as part of the 3 year maintenance cycle. There are many reports of missed drains. We are expecting a smaller vehicle to come and clear the narrower roads but it would be very useful for any missed drains to be reported to a Councillor with if possible a photograph of the drain and situation.

Several grass verges around road junctions have overgrown causing vision issues. We will report to DCC and monitor.

Beating of the Bounds is due to take place on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August. Arrangements are being put in in place. Posters will be put up soon. The Moor Management Committee will provide refreshments on route. More details elsewhere in this Pump.

Thank you to Leigh and Lynn for allowing us to gather in their garden to set a moth trap. We enjoyed some incredible results from tiny micro Moths to huge ones as big as our hands! The children loved the moths and really enjoyed sweep netting among the long grasses in the churchyard. This method of catching bugs proved to be very successful as they found a variety of Butterflies, Grasshoppers, Beetles and Spiders.

The weekend was a perfect opportunity to create a list of the wildflowers in the churchyard - with the help of Jess and her expert knowledge of wildflowers we recorded over 30 different species. # Hatherleigh History Society Record of Harborn A Chargenic of the Room A Chargenic of the Room

Here at the History Society we have been really busy with enquiries regarding families who once lived here, the Jubilee Path created as a commemoration of Queen Victoria`s Diamond Jubilee and the benches made by blacksmith John Petherick (1867-1953). Martin Hartnett has been busy photographing and documenting some of these around town. (For more information and the photographs go to our Hatherleigh History Society Facebook Page )

Something that recently came to light once again in our files was about a descendant of Reverend Craddock Glascott, the well known Vicar of Hatherleigh. She was called Anna Leonowens who wrote "Anna and the King of Siam". Her grandfather had served in India and as often happened in those days, had an Indian mistress, Anna took the name Leonowens from her husband in India but tried to hide her origins. She had served for almost six years as tutor and governess to the children of the King of Siam in Bangkok. She also wrote two other books which were published about her experiences, "Romance in the Harem" and "An English Governess at the Siamese Court". Anna made up several fictional accounts of her origins because of the discrimination about Anglo-Indians, these were proved to be untrue. She went on to found a number of schools in America and Canada, one of them being the 'Nova Scotia College of Art and Design'. Anna was born in Ahmednagar India in 1831 and died in Montreal in 1915, her fame of course lives on in the musical "The King and I", originally starring Yul Brynner and Deborah Kerr.

Another link to the Glascott family was with the Morris family who lived at Fishleigh, and here again we had an enquiry about the William Morris Monument on the top of the moor. William Morris had command of the left hand squadron during the famous `Charge of the Light Brigade` at Balaclava and the great grandfather of the person making the enquiry had command of the right hand squadron of the `Charge`. This man was also badly wounded just like Morris and was taken to the hospital at Scutari where he was nursed by Florence Nightingale. Having survived his terrible wounds and the implant of the metal plate on his head William Morris was later sent to India where he of course died. The other Captain also went to India but with a distinguished military career behind him became a General. The film "Charge of the Light Brigade" didn`t actually use Hatherleigh for any of the scenes of Morris`s home or marriage!

#### St. Thomas of Canterbury, Northlew

We postponed our Patronal Festival as cases of the virus were going up in the area. Having a crowded Victory Hall in the event of rain didn't seem a good idea. However, Thomas Becket deserves a mention, for anyone who cares to read it.

Archbishop Thomas Becket and King Henry the Second were friends and allies until they disagreed over certain matters of "Right" and "Wrong", as they saw them. It seems as if, basically, Becket, who was very popular with the citizens of Canterbury, wanted to keep affairs of Church and State separate. Especially financial ones, no doubt!

Anyway, it seems that some over-keen Knights, trying to help the King, put the poor Archbishop to the sword in Canterbury Cathedral. This dastardly act caused uproar among the ordinary people, and he King was beside himself with grief and remorse. In a fit of rage, when trying - and failing - to persuade Becket to see things his way, Henry had shouted, "Who will rid me of this turbulent Priest?" Probably he didn't expect the Knights to hear him and act on his words! The King walked the highways and lanes of the land - or some of it - dressed in rags and trying to atone for his hasty words. Meanwhile Becket became a Saint, hundreds were healed after having contact with items connected to the Archbishop, and Churches, including ours, were dedicated to him.

For almost nine hundred years his example of humility, honesty and care for his people, and his personal courage have inspired generations of children - especially in Northlew.






