

The Night Sky September 2022

The Autumnal equinox (which marks the start of Autumn) in the Northern Hemisphere will happen on the 23rd of September. The length of day and night will be roughly equal across the globe. September 10th will see a Full, Harvest Moon. New Moon falls on September 25th and it is at this time that we can best observe fainter celestial objects such as galaxies and nebulae. This is because the Moon's light will not wash them out. The constellations of Summer are still visible at this time of year. It is also a good time to observe the Milky Way. You just need a clear dark sky, free of light pollution. Look up and that faint misty band of light you can see is the Milky Way. One of the most recognisable constellations at this time of year is that of Cygnus, The Swan. It forms a cross shape in the night sky. Cygnus can easily be located as it will be at the zenith. This is the point in the sky directly over our heads. It is a great part of the night sky to observe with a pair of binoculars. You may come across deep sky objects such as star clusters and nebulae.



Species of the Month

September—Grass Snake



Conservation Communities - Torrington to Hatherleigh Help build up a picture of the wildlife in our area by telling Devon Biodiversity Records Centre (www.dbrc.org.uk)

You may have spotted grass snakes basking in the sun over the summer. Adult grass snakes can grow to 1 and a half metres, the females are usually bigger than the males.

Grass snakes are greenish in colour, with a yellow and black collar. They are paler underneath and have dark markings down the sides.



Why DBRC need to know about grass snakes: There are very few records of reptiles within the Conservation Communities area, although grass snakes have been spotted throughout the summer. Send in your records to put this species on the map in your parish!

Grass snakes are the only UK snake to lay eggs, which are clumped together in groups of 10 - 40, one egg measures

2.5-3cm.

The eggs are laid in piles of rotting vegetation, a garden compost heap makes a perfect spot! The young hatch throughout August and September, looking much the same as the



adults, but about the size of a pencil. You might spot some of these youngsters, out in the sun or tucked away beneath pots in the garden.

- · Grass snakes are often found near water.
- Their favourite prey is amphibians, but they will also eat small mammals, birds and fish where they can.
- Next month, in October, they will start to prepare for hibernation, finding a sheltered, humid spot away from the cold. Here in the South West, where the weather is quite mild, hibernation can be delayed.

Congratulations - Okehampton Show Winners!

Congratulations to all the winners at Okehampton Show but especially to The Harvest Workers' Co-op for winning First Prize in the Class 4 General Retail, Plants and Produce category at Okehampton Show 2022. Many of us know them from their shop in Red Lion Yard, Okehampton, and more lately, from their stall at Hatherleigh Market. Much of their organic produce is grown at Hilltown Farm just outside Okehampton or resourced from other local, organic and ethical suppliers. The Harvest Workers' Co-op is a not-for-profit social enterprise that aims to:

- Provide access to affordable local organic and sustainable food;
- Support local producers using organic and ecological methods of farming;
- Enable understanding of the social, environmental and health issues of food through educational activities:
- Contributes to building food sovereignty and community strength.

Not only do they supply local quality food, they are also a reassurance that whatever gets thrown at us, they are there for us. Because they are local, their produce wasn't stuck on a shipping container or a lorry due to Brexit, the pandemic or the various strikes or wars affecting global supplies. They have been able to supply us with quality food whatever happens with fossil fuel supplies and fuel price increases. Their knowledge of combating drought and flooding has meant they are able to maintain production despite the extreme weather patterns we have been recently experiencing. Alongside traditional growing methods, they also use the 'No Dig' method which continually enriches the soil and feeds the microbes within the soil. They use minimal packaging and are happy for you to bring your own packaging. Reducing the packaging saves on transportation, incineration and carbon emissions.

They collect their own seeds and use heirloom seeds so the next generation of plants will be stronger and better-adapted to changing growing conditions. They also grow perennial plants which grow back each year with stronger, more-established root systems and reduced reliance on annual sowing. They use beneficial combinations of plants grown together, for example some plants have deep roots that can access and distribute nutrients, while other plants have the properties to repel pests and diseases benefitting nearby plants. These combinations also protect weaker plants from adverse weather conditions and reduces damage from pests.

They have a respect and a connection with nature and a keen eye for observing the subtle changes or indicators that need to be responded to. They do not use pesticides, recognising that these chemicals are both toxic and have the potential to change our DNA. Plants naturally increase in histamine as soon as they are picked. After weeks or months of cold storage, these elevated histamine levels can lead to histamine intolerance in our bodies. Much of Harvest Workers' Co-op produce has been picked at 5am on the day we go to their shop and buy it!

Thinking of next year??..... WHAT! Already!??

As I walked across from Lidl's to Waitrose when I was shopping today, I was stunned by the fact that the established shrubs at the front of Waitrose carpark were either dead or looked like they were dying. In my own garden, all my marigolds, which usually keep flowering and flowering until October, look like they are on their last legs and given that it got up to 47 degrees in my greenhouse, it's not surprising that everything is having a short season (don't think I'll be having tomatoes at Christmas like I have before!)

I always make a mental note of what does well and what doesn't each year but this year I have been particularly looking at what seems to cope well with drought conditions in the flower border and what grows well in the allotment with minimal water and a bit of judicious planting.

In the flower border, if we are going to have the same drought conditions next year as this, then I will be growing loads more Echinacea, Liatris, Scabious. Lucifer, Verbena Bonariensis, Red Hot Poker, Geums, Dahlias, Gauras and Argyrathemum. Given that I have only given them a quick splash 4 times since May, they are all doing pretty well. So, have a look through your plants and see what is thriving (or surviving!) and what is not and check out what you can buy that is going to be OK with very fry conditions.

In the allotment I do pack things quite close together because I don't have much space but all that close planting is great for conserving water as the soil doesn't get baked as it would do in spaced planting. Yes, you can end up with smaller produce (apart from my Stonehead cabbages which are HUGE this year) but the lushness of the vegetation keeps that nice moist microclimate around the roots.

So..... what's done well this year?..... Mangetout and sugar snap peas have been brilliant. Cabbage and all other brassicas have done really well and the carrots are stonking!!! I always grow the carrots in a wide but close planting in between leeks, fennel, coriander and dill to foil the carrot root fly and it works like a dream. The swede are lush and I also grew Kohlrabi for the first time which has proved a winner. The only things that have really suffered have been the runner beans, French beans and Fabada beans. All the pods are quite short but the broad beans have been the best ever!

I think, more and more, we will have to think about altering our planting schedule, changing the types of things we grow and planting with water retention in mind..... but hey-ho.... it all adds to the rich tapestry of a gardener's life!

This year, I would very much think about letting some things in the border and the allotment go to seed so you can collect and dry for next year as I am pretty sure that fresh seeds for next year will either be in short supply, very expensive or both.

The Quickest Ever Most Summery Salad

If you have some big fat tomatoes that you have grown, thinly slice them across and lay them on a plate in a circle with thinly sliced Mozzarella balls and lovely big Basil leaves tucked under each slice of tom and Mozzarella, Drizzle with Balsamic vinegar and and bit of salt and ground black pepper. This is a lovely salad with a barbecue, pizza or just on it's own.

OLD SCHOOLS COFFEE MORNINGS

Happy September everyone! I just thought I would give a short update on how the Old Schools Coffee mornings have gone since the market temporarily moved to the Community Centre.

In the beginning of the year, numbers were a little bit lower than they had been, but we realised that this could also have been due to covid issues. Our regular friends continued to meet and enjoy each other's company. We were delighted that the numbers gradually climbed to nearer normal throughout spring and over the summer months it has proved extremely popular and a great resource for the town on a Tuesday morning. It has been a great informal place for friends to gather in groups to meet up and exchange news.

The charities sponsoring the mornings have done extremely well this year, and everyone is very pleased with the results of their efforts. What's been a bit trickier is the running of them, as we have a very small band of people (Lynn and anyone else around!) who mop up the gaps to keep it going for everyone. The popularity of the coffee morning means we would really like to keep it running. So if you find yourself at a loose end on a Tuesday morning and would like to help out even for an hour, please contact me (810302) and we'll slot you in. I also thought it would be helpful to let you know how simple it is to run a coffee morning for your charity.

What do I need to do? Simply turn up 20 mins before you want to open (usually some parents arrive after school drop-off just before 9.00), turn on all the kettles, whip out some cups, saucers and mugs, unload your goodies onto plates, put out the Coffee Morning notice board at the end of the Square and outside the door, and wait for the crowds to arrive. What do I need to bring? Yourself and a couple of team members, tea, coffee, sugar, milk, biscuits, cakes, savouries etc. Raffle prizes /tombola/plants/books/flowers are all extras that have proven to be a really popular fundraiser, but you don't need to have them to run a successful morning. 

Go on a Bear Hunt in North Devon this autumn

North Devon is set to host a colourful 'Bear Hunt' public art sculpture trail this autumn.

Local artists are currently decorating 25 individual five-foot-tall bears that will form a series of mini trails in around Barnstaple, Bideford, Torrington, Ilfracombe and South Molton.

The Bear Hunt art trail will run throughout September and October in aid of Children's Hospice South West (CHSW).

The charity, which runs three children's hospices, including Little Bridge House in Fremington near Barnstaple, has joined forces with The Art of Fundraising to deliver the project.



As well as helping to raise the profile of the hospice, it is hoped that the trail will also bring significant footfall and economic benefit to the host locations and surrounding areas.

CHSW Bear Hunt project coordinator Kate Romo said: "We're really looking forward to seeing how all the artists choose to decorate their bears and can't wait to see them form such a fun trail for people to follow in and around beautiful North Devon.

"We hope it will be hugely popular with both locals and visitors, who as well as being able to discover these wonderful pieces of bear art, will also be able to enjoy visiting the towns and villages in which they are located."

Among the artists taking part are Phil Creek from Ottery St Mary; Mau Mau from Barnstaple; John Hurford from Chulmleigh; Kathy Nettles from Holsworthy; Sally Rich from Exmouth; Jenny Pymont from Paignton; and Jo Brown from Teignmouth.

There will also be a number of artist-celebrity collaborations, with former England and Somerset county cricketer Marcus Trescothick, and jockey Tom Scudamore, among those set to get creative.

"It's going to be wonderful to see the personalities and styles of all the artists reflected in the bears," added Kate.

"There will be a special trail app launching soon to help people track down all the bears and learn more about the artists and the work of CHSW."
