- 3. Contributions/questions from parishioners/electorate**
  - a) R, Burrow: -**
    - stated that himself Ben Bailey and Dist.Cllr.Kimber were not onside with Kingswood Homes**
    - the heads of terms were not legally binding**
    - he would help in any way with a public consultation and was willing to be co-opted onto the council to help take the matter forward**
  - b) B. Bailey:-**
    - there was no flexibility in the sum of £110,000.00**
    - he guaranteed that if the town council did not proceed with the offer on the table, a Tesco supermarket would be on site within four years**
    - Kingswood Homes would not go bankrupt**
  - c) Mrs.Walters and Mrs Laycock voiced their concerns over certain aspects contained in the proposals eg predicted figures for stall rental,electric feed in tariff. Other uses for the building**
