

The Night Sky March 2023

Nights are starting to get shorter as we approach spring. There are still many interesting celestial objects to observe in the night sky. March 7th is the night of the Full Moon. March 21st is the night of the New Moon. It is at this time that fainter deep sky objects such as galaxies and nebulae are best observed.

One of my favourite constellations to observe in March is Ursa Major, The Great Bear. Even in a pair of binoculars there are many interesting sites ranging from double stars (stars that may be gravitationally bound together) to galaxies.

A good way to find these deep sky objects is to use a planisphere which may have the brighter objects marked out. The plough, which is an asterism (a pattern of stars that is not a constellation) is easily seen in the northern part of the sky. It makes up part of Ursa Major.

The spring equinox falls on March 20th and the length of day and night will be roughly equal. This day marks the first day of spring in the northern hemisphere.







Wasabi And Ginger Pork Balls With Noodles

This is a delicious warming recipe that makes a change from a normal soup or stew.


500g minced pork (makes 20 balls)

A pack of medium egg noodles which need to be pre-cooked until just tender

Small punnet of mushrooms (sliced finely)

Bunch of spring onions(sliced finely)

- 1 thumb of ginger (grated)
- 1-3 cloves of garlic
- 1 litre stock (chicken, pork or veg)
- 1 very large egg (beaten)



- 4 tbsp light soy sauce
- 3 tbsp rice wine vinegar (or you can use an equal mix of malt vinegar, water and sherry)

Some white pepper to taste

You can add any other appropriate veg to the broth that you have to hand. Sliced cabbage, sweetcorn, green pepper, sliced chilli etc

Don't add salt as the soy, rice wine vinegar, stock and wasabi all have a high salt content

Put half your onions (white parts), half your garlic and half your ginger in your stock with some pepper, 3 tbsp of the soy and all the rice wine vinegar. Bring to the boil and simmer for a while.

In a bowl thoroughly hand mix your pork, egg, remaining soy, garlic and ginger, pepper and the wasabi and roll into firm balls slightly smaller than a golf ball.

Bring stock to boil again and drop your balls in. Simmer balls in broth on a medium heat for about 10 mins then add your mushrooms and other veg then finally add your noodles and sliced spring onion greens just to warm through.

Serve immediately and whoof it down!

At our last meeting we enjoyed seeing the remainder of the James Ravilious photographs from the Beaford Arts collection of Hatherleigh during the 1970's and 1980's. We know many people couldn't make the meeting but we will try and show these wonderful photographs again, perhaps on a weekend.

Our next meeting in Old Schools is on Monday 13th March at 7.30pm when Dr. Janet Few is our guest speaker and will be talking on the subject of `Victorian Asylums`. Visitors and guests welcome £3 includes tea/coffee & biscuits.

With the wonderful production of `Oliver` by the Hatherleigh Players still very much in mind, it was interesting to look back on the diary of Thomas Abell which we have in our records, and how he remembered his life here in Hatherleigh and how the poor lived and survived in hard times. This is a brief account and part of the story of how hard life was but with determination, it was possible to rise above poverty.

Thomas was born on 16th May 1848 in Buddle Lane, the third child of ten, his father was a boot and shoe maker and they all lived in a house with two bedrooms, a kitchen and a small room and his father's workshop. A tablespoon of flour and a little milk sufficed for the whole family, dinner sometimes consisted of boiled potatoes squeezed up; for supper bread and dripping. Thomas was often sent to pick wood wherever he could find it for firewood and also to Hatherleigh Moor cutting furze (gorse) which he tied in a bundle at either end and with a bag to stop being pricked, carried it home on his head.

At the age of eight Thomas joined his brother on a farm during the harvest where he would carry sheaves or go to and fro with drinks for the men. When he was eleven he went to another farm in Inwardleigh where he fetched and attended the cows, all for 6d (old money) per week.

Thomas's story doesn't just end with him being an agricultural labourer for life, he went on to get an apprenticeship with a very good builder, taught himself taxidermy for extra cash, went to America and turned his hand to many jobs of work. He returned to Hatherleigh and married his sweetheart who was a maid for the Veale's at Passaford, then moved to Exmouth and started his own very successful building business and was awarded an MBE, he died in 1943.

We will run Thomas's story in full once again on our Facebook page soon.



Dog Owners and Dog Walkers

Following a serious occurrence of sheep worrying on Hatherleigh Moor with one sheep having been maimed and another unaccounted for, the **Moor Management Committee** feel it necessary to make dog owners and dog walkers **aware of the Law** when walking their dogs,

"On Areas of Access land designated under the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000, (CROW) your dog must be on a short lead of no more than two metres between 1st March and 31st of July. Outside of these times dogs must be kept under effective control if livestock is present, preferably on a lead"

Hatherleigh Moor is an area of open access land as described, much loved and appreciated by many. To keep it as such and to meet certain environmental issues required, it has to be grazed with cattle and sheep. We would ask all to respect those animals and their owners.
