HATHERLEIGH MARKET

336. Cllr. Burrow gave councillors an update on how the Hatherleigh Market public meeting went

- **Meeting was attended by between 60-70 people and the Friends of Hatherleigh |Market ran through an update presentation followed by a Q & A session**
- **Attendees at the meeting were engaged and asked a series of good follow up questions in the following areas**
 - a) **Parking fees, traffic management, speed limits, management/adoption of roads**
 - b) **Events management, alcohol/licensing/TENS**
 - c) **Litter bins and keeping the surrounding area tidy during events**
 - d) **Café provision at the market**
 - e) **Future fur and feathers auctions at the site**

Pledges Update

- **as at 12.03.24 total stands at £66,200 in pledges from the community/two thirds of the way to the £100K target required from the community**

Practical completion

- **Kingswood advising that practical completion will be end of May 2024**

Community Benefit Society

- **The Community Benefit Society “Hatherleigh Community Market Ltd” was formally registered on 27th February 2024 and we have passed our financial conduct authority checks**
- **An interim management committee has been appointed – (Tory Rogers, Debbie Kimber, Richard Burrow, Patrick Kimber) until the CBS has members (shareholders) who will then vote to appoint a new management committee**

Additional Grant Funding

- **The Community Benefit Society is eligible for £10,000 grant funding from the Rural England Prosperity Fund and an application for this will be made as soon as the bank account for the CBS has been set up**
