Hatherleigh Bellringers

We're nearly there.

By the time the December Pump hits your doormat, we anticipate Hatherleigh's new bell frame will be under construction in the tower, and our bells will be back home and awaiting their rehang. We still can't give the date for our 'first ring' but there's a good chance it will be before Christmas.

The project has been a very long haul for the bell team. At some time in 2019 we discussed the problems we were having with the old oak frame and long ropes, but plans to put these right were frustratingly halted by Covid. Fundraising for the £75,000 we needed was eventually started in late 2021, independently of the church's own restoration project. Much of the tough, physical work in clearing the tower and moving the old frame was undertaken by the ringers themselves.



In mid-November two ringers visited our bellhanger near Bath to see the new steel frame under construction - you may have seen the photos on Facebook. At long last, we could see that our goal was nearing completion. Constructing the frame and rehanging the bells will be undertaken soon by two professional bellhangers with, again, the assistance of Hatherleigh Bellringers. We can't wait to get back into the tower once more to ring bells for Hatherleigh Parish Church - and all of you.

Thanks to Reverend Leigh, a Service of Dedication for the bells will be held early in the New Year and we will be organising a celebration event.

We would like to thank every one of you who has helped and encouraged us to reach our goal. Thanks go especially to Reverend Leigh, the PCC, and to those who have supported our project with many generous donations and so much practical help over the last four years.



'Tis soon the season to be merry....... 'tis also the season to buy too much, eat too much and very often waste too much, so here's an excellent, tasty recipe to make your Christmas Day leftovers into something really special.

Cold Turkey and Ham Pie





and you will still have loads of other things to eat, so to ensure your ingredients don't get binned by leaving them in the fridge and then thinking better of using them, make a conscious decision to put these things aside in the freezer:

Turkey meat, Ham, leftover pigs in blankets, leftover stuffing, even a tiny bit of bread sauce. Work out the size of cake tin (preferably with a loose bottom) you are going to use and ensure you have enough leftover goodies to fill it. Separately store stock from the bottom of the turkey and ham trays (the stuff that's already going to jelly when the pan cools) You will need about 500ml. You could be really good and boil up your turkey carcase with a little water to make more stock.

When you decide "it's make the pie day" get everything out of the freezer and get the following other ingredients together for the loose filling:

1 large onion finely chopped and gently fried in butter, ground pepper and finely chopped herbs such as parsley and thyme.

Roughly chop the ham, turkey, sausage and stuffing and then mix thoroughly with the onion, pepper, herbs and bread sauce, making sure you have plenty of ingredients to fill your chosen tin.

Moving on to the hot water pastry you will need:

375g plain flour, 1tsp salt, 135g of lard and butter mix, 195ml of very hot water

Melt the butter and lard in a saucepan and add the salt and flour to cook off, stirring all the time with a wooden spoon and finally add the water bit by bit over a very low heat whilst stirring vigorously. When it's all coming together, remove the dough from the pan and as soon as you can, knead your dough until it forms a smooth ball. You will need to work quickly as it must not become cold. Roll out a 1/4 of the dough to make your lid and the rest needs to be roughly rolled out and fitted into your greased tin. You will need to squish it in and up the sides using your fist and your fingers to bring it up the sides. You don't need to treat this like normal pastry, think Playdough and you'll be fine!

Put all your filling in the pie, gently firm it but not too much as you want little pockets for your stock to go into later so that your pie holds together when cut. Put your lid on then squidge and crimp your edges over the lid. In all, when your pie is ready to go into the oven, the base, walls and lid should be of equal thickness with no holes or splits.

Make a hole in the centre of the lid. I usually bake my pie with an old wide metal piping nozzle in the top to ensure it's easy to add the stock later. Brush with **beaten egg** and bake for 45 minutes at 180 degrees.

When the pie is cooked and partially cooled you can add the jelly.

Mix **20g butter** with your **500ml of hot stock** together with **1 sachet of powdered gelatine**. Slowly pour the stock in the top. You will find you need to do this in stages and wiggle the pie around as it will filter down and spread throughout the pie. You may need to come back to it a few times but don't stop until it is impossible to add more stock.

Refrigerate your pie and leave until completely cold. If you make it in the morning, you may be able to pop it out and cut it in the evening but it is probably best to make it one day and eat it the next.

Serve with salad, pickles, chutneys or coleslaw.... and friends, but if you have more pie than friends then you can slice, wrap in greaseproof, bag and freeze for lunches later.

p.s. I did try layering my pie once so it looked "pretty" but the layers stop the stock filtering through properly and it fell apart when I served it... so don't bother with pretty, just do tasty!



Repair Café year one: a great success!

Hatherleigh Repair Café celebrates its first anniversary this month, and what a year we've had! It's been a hugely popular addition to the community, with **145 items** brought in for repair, **75%** of which we have mended.


