Harry says...

For me, dyslexia makes my head feel messy and foggy - I have to try and unravel the text I'm reading. The words bounce around on the page, I read words and letters back-to-front, or even rearrange the letters to form a completely different word, like 'felt' becomes 'left'. I lose my place, sometimes skipping a line, or reading the same one again.

When I created this piece, I made a question mark out of a messy ball of wool and imported it into my hair, to show how my head feels woolly when reading. The page is filled with tangled wool that form words here and there, showing common issues I have with words. The word 'dyslexia' is clear because it is behind my coloured overlay, which helps me to keep the text clear and helps me to keep my place.





The Night Sky October 2024

Peak rates are about 10 meteors per hour.

With recent word from the bell hanger in Somerset, Matthew Higby, that our new metal bell frame was well under construction attention was turned to preparing the inside of the tower for its arrival.

This has involved the creation of 'pockets' in the stonework to accept the foundation beams and concreting of level pads to Matthews specification to provide a stable surface for the new frame to sit on. The work was both laborious and messy and was another great team effort from the ringers who were lucky to have been assisted by David Meardon and Matt Wonnacott. Massive thanks to them both for their time and expertise. With the work to prepare the tower now complete we are ready to fit the new frame and eagerly await its arrival. We are hopeful that by next months Pump we will have dates on when the frame and bells will return to Hatherleigh.

We are also pleased to report that we have just taken delivery of our new set of muffles. Muffles are traditionally made of leather and attach to the clappers to 'dull' the sound of the bell at such events as funerals and Remembrance day. Our old set was in a bad state of repair and, with much Gaffer tape and many cable ties required to keep them secured and functional during use, fitting them whilst lying under a large bell was awkward at best! With the new ones being secured by velcro straps fitting the new set should be a lot simpler. We would like to thank the individuals who made a donation specifically to cover the full cost of the new set of muffles.

As we move closer to Christmas a reminder to check out the wooden items made from the the old oak bell frame we are selling. More items will be added very soon including some turned items, so keep and eye on our Facebook page and remember don't leave it too late as we are rapidly using up the timber and once its gone its gone!



Parsnip and Orange Tray Cake

If you have a couple of parsnips hanging around in the fridge or you've had a bumper crop this season and you've already blanched and frozen enough for roasties, stews and curries for the whole year, made soup and you are looking for something a little different to do with your parsnips then this is a perfect recipe; it may sound a little weird but then carrot cake is a favourite so why not give parsnip a go.

You will need:

140g finely grated parsnip,

100g sultanas,

Zest of 1 large or 2 smaller oranges (hold back a few thin sliced shavings for top and the juice for the icing),

175g soft brown sugar,

175ml sunflower oil,

3 large eggs,

175g self-raising flour,

1 tsp bicarbonate of soda,

1 tsp ground cinnamon

1/2 tsp ground nutmeg

For the icing:

175g icing sugar

The juice of one of the oranges

(may need adjustment dependant on size of orange)

Thoroughly beat your eggs and then incorporate your sugar and oil. Add the parsnip, sultana and zest. Add the flour, bicarb and spices bit by bit and mix well in but don't over do it as this can make your sponge tough.

Lightly grease a 7" x 11" tray and line the bottom with a piece of greaseproof paper.

Pour in the mix and cook for 25 mins at 180 degrees

When slightly cooled and out of the tray, drizzle over the mix of orange juice and icing sugar. Leave to completely cool before cutting into pieces.



Your 10 Councillors

- One member of the public attended and asked Councillors to consider the lack of safe pavement space outside the auction rooms on sale days especially at the beginning and end of the school day.
 This will be considered by Councillors. If you have reports or photos of obstructions or poor parking please do get in touch with a Councillor.
- We are still considering how to make the School entrance safe for pupils and parents at the start
 and end of the school day. We have asked DCC Highways department to visit. We will also ask our
 new Police officers to attend the next meeting to ask their opinion. But can we remind parents not
 to block the road or to park in the Vets surgery parking spaces. Spaces are available in the
 Community Centre and the Town car park.
- We now own the Phonebox in Town. It will be painted and then used as a source of information for Residents. If you have ideas for its use please get in touch with a Councillor.
- Millennium Corner: We are still awaiting a response from DCC about the repairs needed.
 Photographs will be taken and sent to DCC to stress the urgency of repairs.
- Town Square: We are still awaiting information from WDBC in regards to the cost of repairs and
 insurance before we are able to decide whether we can afford to take ownership of the Square.
 Ideally we would love to own our Square.
- Hanging Baskets: These have now been taken down. Many of the baskets that were up were in a sorry state due to the lack of volunteers to care for them. Do residents want hanging baskets around our Town? Should they just be around the Square. What do residents think?
- Both bus shelters have been refurbished by Councillors, but the railings outside the post office still
 need to be painted. The area to the side of the Town bus shelter is in need of repair. We will
 attempt to find out who owns it and is responsible for it's maintenance.
- The War Memorial is badly in need of repair. The render on the bottom skirt is cracked and missing
 in some areas. Councillor Barrs will inspect prior to repairs being carried out.
- Hatherleigh Market: The draft lease is now largely agreed. There was a delay in the glass sides
 delivery so there is a further delay. The internal fixtures and fittings cannot be installed until the
 structure is weatherproof. Kingswood homes have given an updated completion date of the middle
 to end of October. People who have previously pledged money to support the market are being
 contacted to ask if they are still prepared to do so. If you haven't already pledged but would like to
 please use the link below. Space is short here so please go to the Friends of Hatherleigh Market
 website for up to date information www.fhm-cbs.org
- 20 is Plenty Campaign: We have some larger posters to put up around Town. Councillors are still
 awaiting a date to undertake the training to complete this.
- The small bridge in Island Park is badly in need of repair. Does anyone have any suggestions of an attractive replacement here? For instance a safe feature rope bridge? A decorative metal bridge? Ideas and/or offers of help are needed please.


