



Community led housing is a growing movement of people taking action and managing housing projects that build the decent and affordable homes that the country so desperately needs. Anyone can start, volunteer and deliver a community led housing project. You don't need to work in housing, you don't need a degree in architecture, you don't need to be a builder. If you think a change is needed, you can lead that change.

The local community group or organisation owns, manages or stewards the homes and in a manner of their choosing, and this may be done through a mutually supported arrangement with a Registered Provider that owns the freehold or leasehold for the property.

The benefits to the local area and/or specified community are clearly defined and legally protected in perpetuity. A community land trust (CLT) is a not-for-profit organisation that is made up of community members. CLTs are a way for communities to build, bring back into life or protect buildings and services that are important to them.

It is intended to set up Hatherleigh Community Land Trust as a Community Benefit Society for the purpose of developing community led affordable housing and bespoke housing that would be available for shared ownership under the Home Ownership for People with Long Term Disabilities Scheme.







Check Out Your Back Catalogue

Now that we are in the pleasant lull between Summer and having to winterize the garden it is the time to relax, enjoy the sun, enjoy the fruits of your labours and sit out under the parasol in your garden chair with a glass of wine or a cup of tea and think about your "back catalogue". I don't mean you should have your ear-pods in listening to old albums of Donny Osmond or The Bay City Rollers! I mean your "back catalogue" of garden plants.

This is the perfect time to think about what really worked in the garden this year, what plants you really should have had more of, which plants only just clung on to life over the last winter and which new plants you love but you are not sure if they will make it through another soggy winter. Buying plants can be expensive so use what you've got and think about propagating now to make next year's display even better. Some plants can be multiplied by division, some plants can be reproduced from cuttings, some plants can be propagated by simply saving the seeds for next year and others seeds need a little helping hand to ensure they will germinate next year. Here are a few examples:

The Japanese Anemone, Rudbeckia, Liatris, Astrantia, Hosta and a whole host of other plants can simply be dug up and divided at the end of the summer; either to be re-planted in different areas or in pots.

Hydrangeas, Tibouchina, Geranium and various shrubby plants can be propagated either from soft or hard wood cuttings. For Hydrangeas and Tibouchina simply pinch out a leaf pairing with no flower, squish into some compost in small modules and leave sitting in a shallow tray of water until you start to see roots appear. Some other shrubby plants are a little more reluctant to take such as roses but if you plant enough cuttings you will definitely get some. Small cuttings from Geraniums you are going to try and over-winter can be arranged in a pot of moist compost until they root and then they can be potted individually. The secret to over-wintering Geraniums (older plants or cuttings) is to ensure they are barely watered from below and leaf and leaf debris is kept to a minimum so they don't rot or develop leaf mould; the same applies to Argyranthemum and Osteospermum.

Some plants will simply give up their seeds when they are ready such as Love-Lies-Bleeding, French Marigolds, Poppy, Salvias, Snapdragons, Dwarf Pink and Trailing Lobelia. All you need to do is wait until the seeds are ready on the plant (green seeds will not germinate) and then collect, bag and keep in dry conditions ready for next year.

Other plants will give their seed but they need a helping hand to be ready to germinate. Cosmos, Echinacea, Lupin, Astrantia and some others need to be cold treated by sticking them in a tub in the fridge for a few weeks before planting to increase the chances of germination. Give these various basic methods of propagation a go as you've got nothing to lose! 


