Hello again.

Are you feeling well rested? Hmm, most of us struggle to find a gap in life's demands to catch up on a little R & amp; R. Whether you're working, looking after family or attempting to be retired, life has a way of filling up the gaps and leaving us feeling pretty



spent. And when you do get to bed? How many of us lose sleep finding our heads spinning with things we haven't had time to process during the day? God does have an answer to this, and this has been the subject of a recent spate of sermons and school assemblies I've been sharing over the last couple of weeks; it's called 'taking Sabbath'. This idea first turns up in what we call 'the ten commandments' that God gave to Moses as his 'terms of a covenant' between God and his people. The trouble with calling them 'commandments' is that we immediately want to rebel against being told what to do. It's more healthy perhaps, to stick to what the Jews originally called them; the 'ten words'. Words to describe a healthy way of life, for individuals and communities to flourish, and to do so in relationship with the God who made us, knows us and knows how we function best. And taking a clear day off in seven is his answer to the incessant business of life; a day to take stock, reflect, rest and relax in His company. For the Jews, this used to be [and still is] from sundown Friday to sundown Saturday, although through a complicated history this has come down to us as being Sundays. I wonder if you remember the 'Keep Sunday Special' campaign that fought against the changes to Sunday trading laws back in 1994? At the time, these restrictions seemed unfair on traders but the argument against change was that workers, especially in low paid jobs, would be left with little choice about working constantly without the benefits of a regular break. In these days of epidemic level stress, mental ill health and breakdowns, it seems we are reaping what we've sown in disregarding God's recommendations [although I don't pretend this is a simple case of one solution to fix everything!]

However you read it, the simple truth is we need to stop, regularly from the frenetic race of life to recharge and find our breath for the next stint of 'doing'. This week I urge you to take a look at the pattern of your life, and how it's leaving you feeling; listen to yourself and your needs, and see if there is a way to factor in a 24 hour stop in each week; it will do you good, I promise.

One group of people who rarely get to stop are those who find themselves being carers for family members. Our first session of our carer's mutual support group was well attended and helpful to those who came. Although just an hour [24 would be a bit tricky to organise] even a short reflective stop like this is a help. Our next session is on Wednesday 10th July, 11.00 a.m. in Old Schools, Hatherleigh,

The light of the moon won't wash out the fainter objects. Full Moon falls on July 21st. Mercury is the planet of the month and is visible after the Sun has set. It is most easily visible on the 22nd July. This is because the planet is at its greatest eastern elongation. This basically means it will be visible. The evening sky low in the west after sunset.



Bell-frame Bounty

Bells are packed together very closely inside a tower, and supported on a frame. In the past, bell frames were made of wood, but now many wood frames are failing and need to be replaced. Hatherleigh's was no exception.

Our oak frame was installed in 1883. At the time, many local frames were made by Thomas Hooper and Harry Stokes, a pair of bellhangers who worked together in Woodbury, the other side of Exeter. We know that Stokes visited Hatherleigh and took measurements and notes but we don't think he undertook the work itself. It is possible that the job was carried out by a local carpenter, and very likely that the oak came from a nearby estate.

We have been overwhelmed by local support for the bells in Hatherleigh: here is your chance for a special keepsake. The bellringing team have carefully dismantled the old oak frame to leave it as intact as possible. If you were at the church fête in June you will have seen the range of unique candle sticks and night-light holders crafted by Mark Wonnacott

from the bell frame wood and the bell ropes, which are now available to order. Each beautiful piece will be authenticated by a stamp or label.

They will make ideal Christmas presents, so please get your orders in early. All proceeds from sales will go to the Hatherleigh Bellringers Bells Restoration Fund. There are pictures going on our Facebook page shortly and you can message us to place an order.



This wonderful Time Of The Year

As I am writing this it is mid June, this is the start of my favourite time of the year. There's some colour in the borders, the allotment that was a desert of un-dug soil a few weeks ago (apart from the garlics planted last year) has now been chopped, edged and weeded (mostly thanks to my lovely husband!) and all the veg plants are starting to do their thing. Bean and pea tendrils are starting to cling on to their poles, Broad Beans are in flower, rows of carrots, parsnips and swede are coming on and the salad leaves and herbs are ready to be used.. Beetroot leaves, spinach, pea shoots and various lettuce are ready to be combined with some of the celery and spring onions and cucumber from the greenhouse to make the first lovely green salads and it will be only a few days until the orange tomatoes will turn red and be ripe to eat.....Isn't nature wonderful!

While it is good to have a coffee in the garden in the morning or spend a few hours at the end of the day with a glass of wine, surveying the lush growth, you still need to keep on top of things but it is mostly management, succession seeding and bug control. The netting came off my cauliflowers and swede this week. Cauliflower can be attacked by cabbage root fly and one day a plant can look vibrant and healthy and the next it can be wilted and heading for the compost heap. The leaves of swede can be annihilated by flea beetles but a bit of netting until they are established works wonders.

As all brassicas are susceptible to cabbage root fly I have netting on my baby cabbage, celeriac, broccoli, sprouts and similar plants at the moment.... just until they are sturdy enough. All of this netting malarkey can be seen as a pain and people give up and buy their brassicas but I prefer to grow my own without pesticides. When it comes to cabbage white butterfly I don't spray. I just keep a look out for butterflies and then get rid of the eggs on the plant when I see them; much better than spraying with pesticides.

One thing that I have been using over the last couple of years, in the allotment but especially in the greenhouse is Neem Oil which is made from the nuts of the Azadirachta Indica Tree (pictured). Neem oil works wonders as an anti fungicide and against all sorts of pesky pests such as flea beetle, greenfly, whitefly, blackfly and spider mite. In a closed environment such as a greenhouse or polytunnel I have found it invaluable.

Anyway..... enjoy your summer in the garden..... it is all a fun learning curve however old you are!
