Dear friends,

Well it has been nice to be reminded what colour the sky is when the clouds aren't there; I'd almost forgotten. And then the flowers! - It has always seemed an odd tradition to me that churches don't have flowers inside during Lent, just when God is



clothing the landscape with them outside. I guess it's another sign of deliberate self-denial that Lent [the six weeks before Easter] is famous for. I've been suggesting in the churches that rather than giving up the chocolate, it might be more useful to look at our character. Is there anything there that could do with being cut out, or added? What aspects of our lives do harm to others, ourselves or the world around us? And what changes could reverse those things to make our lives both blessed and a blessing? A good place to start would be to cultivate a habit of thankfulness. This powerfully counters the negativity to which we can so easily fall prey. I usually start with the kitchen tap, remembering to be grateful for seemingly endless, effortless clean water; what a privilege, one which so many people in this world do not have! Then work outwards from there.

On the 'church rota' page, you should be able to find Easter services in your local church, and I'm sure you'll find a warm welcome if you turn up; visitors and newcomers are always a delight to see.

You might be wondering what the 'relic or red-herring' event is all about on the list. A few years back, a friend and I went off to the Turkish-Iranian border to check out what many had claimed to be the remains of Noah's Ark. Without giving anything away here, I'll be sharing the history of the site along with our findings, with photos, models and a few samples to see. And yes, there is even a connection or two with Easter.

And so as the landscape comes to life with a little Spring warmth, may you find yourselves caught up in the ancient, but ever new Easter account of the one who came and broke the power of death, rising to new life for us all; Jesus Christ.







It is my great pleasure to accept the opportunity to write an article as Mr Monger recuperates after his operation. We are missing him at school, but I am pleased to report that all is well, wis working that hit harder to ensure that the school runs

and everybody is working that bit harder to ensure that the school runs smoothly until he returns to full health and can take up his duties once more.

I joined the school over two years ago and it wasn't long before I felt part of the team and the community it serves. I noticed immediately how the school places importance on all subjects and strives to achieve academic excellence, but not at the expense of the arts, a personal passion of mine. The opportunities and experiences given to the children are expansive and are central to looking after the whole child. My new role as Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator (SENDCO), which I started in September, has been a challenging one. The struggles that our young people and their families are placed under daily are becoming increasingly concerning as demands grow. I have noticed, after over 30 years of teaching experience, how things have changed and not necessarily for the better. New technology has wonderful benefits, but its overuse is impacting on children's ability to converse and interact in the way that I used to as a child. I think it is important that we help children to find new ways to connect with nature, the outdoors and, of course, other people.

We are extremely fortunate to have such a wonderful school site with its own green field (almost dry enough to use!) and a woodland area. The children also have weekly visits from Jensen the dog, who works for Pets as Therapy and regular monthly opportunities to spend time at Skyeridge farm, feeding lambs and calves and helping on a small holding nearby. These experiences are an integral part of school life helping to equip our youngsters with the skills necessary to cope with the pressures placed upon them.

As always, I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone in the Hatherleigh school community and the amazing PTFA, the children, parents/carers, school staff and the governing board for all their hard work and support for the school. Do join us on March 29th for Maintenance Day to help or just come and say hello.

Hot Cross Buns

It's that time of year when the lure of the hot cross bun takes a hold and there is something really nice about making your own and having them fresh from the oven.



You will need:

520 g strong white bread flour, 275 g mixed fruit (soaked in warm water for

about an hour then drained) 85 g castor sugar, 85 g butter (if making by hand then make sure the butter is very soft) 2 tsp yeast, 1 tsp baking powder, 1 large egg beaten, 1 tsp salt, 100ml milk, 100ml water (if making by hand then use warm milk and water) 2 tsp ground mixed spice, 2 tsp ground cinnamon

You will also need:

either apricot jam or thin marmalade to mix with a little boiling water so you can put a gloss on the buns when they just come out of the oven. Plain flour and water mixed to a paste for you to make your cross. I usually just drizzle mine. I piped it this time (trying to be extra posh!) but I don't think it makes a difference and quite frankly, the cross brings nothing to the table flavour wise so I usually go without it. The only benefit of the cross is that people look at a plate of them and immediately know what they are instead of you having to tell them they are just hot cross buns without the cross! If you have a bread maker then shove everything apart from the fruit in on a normal raisin dough cycle, put the fruit in when it tells you to and wait for "the magic"... if not then make and prove your dough as for any raisin bread. The dough should be quite soft... you need a nice soft dough to make good squidgy buns. When risen, break the dough into 12 buns and put on a floured baking tray. Leave to rise again in a warm place for about 20-25 mins. Preheat your oven to 200 degrees. When the buns have risen brush the tops with a little milk and then, if you are putting crosses, drizzle your paste across. Bake in the centre of the oven for about 15-20 mins. As soon as the buns come out, brush them a couple of times with your syrup to get a good gloss.
