Hatherleigh Bellringers

Six Bell Striking Competition

August will be a busy month for the ringers. On Saturday August 9th we host the Six Bell Striking Competition in Hatherleigh. This is a joint competition, held annually with Samford Courtenay. It's in its fourth year, although there was no ringing in Hatherleigh last year because, of course, there were no bells here at the time. On August 9th several visiting teams will compete for certificates and a trophy, with ringing judged on accuracy of striking. Ringing takes place at both venues, and at Hatherleigh will take place between 2 pm and approximately 8 pm.

Bell Tour to Guernsey

During four long years of work on the bells and the tower, the ringers have not held a bell ringing tour. Past tours have taken place within a driveable distance of Hatherleigh, with about five different towers on the route. Each set of bells is rung for about half an hour, and the ringers move on to the next tower. There's usually a pub lunch or a picnic halfway, and sometimes a meal with friends and family back in Hatherleigh in the evening. Ringing tours are always paid for out of the ringers' own pockets.

This year will be something special. A large number of Hatherleigh bellringers, together with family members, are travelling to Guernsey in August for a mini-holiday. Despite the island's small size, Guernsey has several fine sets of bells and the tour will take in four of them. There will be two 10-bell rings at the churches of St Pierre Du Bois and St Peter Town Church, and two 6-bell rings at St Michel du Valle and Ste Marguerite de la Foret. The ringers are staying over the weekend to enjoy the beaches, the local cuisine - and perhaps some liquid refreshment.

Notes from the Council Meeting held on Tuesday 8th July 2025. The next Council meeting will be held on Tuesday 9th September at 7pm in the Community Centre. For more information see our website www.hatherleightowncouncil.org/

Your 9 Councillors are – Mark Reddaway (Chair/Mayor), Rachel Laycock (Deputy), Deb Laing-Trengove, Kay Walters, Donna Lewis, Richard Burrow, Sadie Harrison, Jake Barrs & Will Turner

- After informal meetings with 2 applicants and a written application from a third person Mr Steve Whitehead was appointment to the post of Street Caretaker. We welcome Steve to the team, and we thank the other excellent applicants for their interest but we only had 1 position.
- 2 Members of the public attended to raise the issue of the pending introduction of parking fees in the market car park and the issue of broadband coverage.
- 20 is Plenty: No volunteers from the Town have come forward to help with this scheme. Councillors
 can not do this alone and we need volunteers if you wish to see the scheme adopted.
- The horse sculpture at the school entrance is in need of repair. The original artist will come and inspect it to see what is needed.
- Also the sheep statue in front of the car park needs repair and again the original artist will come to inspect and repair this in due course.
- School Entrance: Another meeting was held an a proposal was put forward by Devon Highways to
 relocate the loading bay further down closer to the garage and to put a 24 hr bus stop closer to
 school to help with congestion. School Governors to investigate the provision of a volunteer
 Crossing Warden.
- WDBC will be approached to ask if a safe pedestrian access could be installed in the Car park.
 Parents are encouraged to park here to walk their children to school and the only exit is the narrow car entrance/exit.
- South Street will remain closed for the foreseeable future. We asked WDBC if Park Road residents
 could be given temporary parking permits for the town car park but sadly they refused.
- Following a residents enquiry it was agreed to write to OpenReach to ask when Hatherleigh could
 expect Full Fibre broadband to be available.
- Dunbia have kindly offered to fund 2 projects in Town. They will provide a new bridge to replace
 the one that had to be removed from Island Park and they will provide a new bench for the area
 beside the town bus stop to replace the damaged one currently there. We are extremely grateful
 for their support of the Town. WDBC will be approached to ask if a safe pedestrian access could be
 installed in the Car park. Parents are encouraged to park here to walk their children to school and
 the only exit is the narrow car entrance/exit.
- Allotments: As per the Terms & Conditions, allotment holders should be offered support and guidance if they are having difficulties from time to time.
- Hatherleigh Market: New bollards will be installed shortly to protect the market square so it is
 available for trading. The Market Working Group will hold a meeting shortly to discuss the
 introduction of parking charges. This revenue is needed to meet financial challenges to keep the
 market viable. The rate will be fixed at £1 per day for all day parking. Fees are also felt necessary to
 stop cars being left permanently in spaces leaving fewer spaces for Market users. Please go to the

The Night Sky August 2025

Nights start to get noticeably darker this month. There is a meteor shower called the Perseids. You can see a Perseid meteor or two on pretty much any night in August. However it's peak is on the night of August 12th going into the early morning if the 13th. Anything between 60 and 80 meteors per hour. There could even be a few fireballs that leave smoke trails in the upper atmosphere. There will be a waning gibbous moon so only the brighter of the meteors will be visible but still it's a great shower to watch. The best time to observe the shower is between 11pm and 4am as it's at this time that the night side of the earth turns into the incoming meteor stream



Stressed?.... You have NO idea!

Just like any living thing (us included), plants suffer from stress. I have, from time to time, used "talking therapies" with my plants; telling them how lovely they look and how well they're doing, not that I think that has any effect whatsoever. I have used my father's alternative technique on occasion; he stood under his plum tree which hadn't given any decent fruit for 3 or 4 years and he said to my mother "If we don't get a decent crop next year then I'm chopping it down!" The next year there were so many plums he didn't know what to do



with them all and my mum certainly got sick of bottling them and making jam. Joking aside, physical stresses caused by nature or bad treatment can have strange effects on plants. Too much water, not enough water, lack of food, too much food, not enough sun, too much sun, being too cold and constricted growth can all affect the little darlings and in some ways they are very like us. If you were stuck in a pair of tight fitting shoes all day then they'd hurt and you couldn't function normally and for plants, if they are stuck in a pot that constricts their roots they don't like it either. If we are in the bright, baking sun then we would put on a hat or move into the shade.... but plants can't move, they wilt. Drooping leaves is a sign to us that the plant is too hot and we may water it but very often, overnight, without watering the plant can seemingly pick up. Letting its leaves droop allows the plant to have less surface area facing the sun and it is a mechanism for them to preserve as much moisture as possible. If you don't eat or drink enough then your body will cease to function normally. If you eat and drink too much then you will be just as useless; the same is true of plants. Tomato plants need even watering. If you are a lazy waterer and forget for a day or two and then think you will make up for it by virtually drowning the plants the next day then the fruit skins will split..... just like the zip would pop on your trousers if you had a 10 course meal and 12 pints of lager! You will always get bigger garlic bulbs if you pull out the scape. With the onions I want to do pickled onions with, I plant the seeds very closely so they are all crowding each other and each plant will out compete the next to create a bud (which I take off if one appears, which isn't often) and then each plant concentrates on growing the biggest bulb possible in the minimal space I have given it and it will mature very small in comparison..... the perfect size for pickled onions! With strawberry plants I will let the older plants make runners but the younger ones I will take the runners off so they will make fruit buds for the next season. So, have some fun getting into the "mind" of your plants and it will bear fruit (literally!)




