Hatherleigh Bellringers

If you live near Hatherleigh Church you'll hear the bells ringing every Wednesday evening practice. You might wonder what we do during that hour-and-a-half*, and what we aim for in good ringing.

When ringing for services, or special occasions like weddings or celebrations, we obviously aim to ring as well as we can. We want to achieve a consistent rhythm, keeping an even gap between 'strikes' - and very definitely avoid clashing of bells ringing at the same time. To ring at a consistently high standard requires a good Ringing Captain, the full concentration of every member of the ringing team, and often a good few years' practice, experience and commitment.

But everyone has to start somewhere. In most towers it's the Ringing Captain that teaches beginners and if you hear a single bell ringing during practice it is probably someone learning the basics, with the Ringing Captain standing by as the beginner learns how to control the rope effectively and safely.

Richard Harrison is our Ringing Captain at Hatherleigh. During practice (and normal ringing), he decides how many bells to ring (we normally ring six or eight), who will ring which bell, and he directs the ringers which 'tune' of notes to ring by calling out 'changes'. The change calls instruct team members to switch positions in the order of ringing. Note that you don't switch actual bells, just the order in which you ring! After a new change is called, you'll hear a difference in the 'tune' of the bells. Richard also controls the ringing pace, points out any bell-handling errors, and reminds us to keep good and safe control of the ropes. He may also be ringing at the same time as directing.

Richard is a regular ringer at Exeter Cathedral, which gives an idea of how good a ringer he is and how lucky we are to have him. Richard has been ringing bells for 46 years! On June 28th he'll will be taking part in the National 12 -bell Striking Contest for the Taylor Trophy in Bristol, as part of the Exeter Cathedral team. The competition takes place every year at a different tower, and this year it is at St Mary Redcliffe. There are nine finalists, whittled down from 26 towers around the country.

All of us wish Richard and the Exeter Cathedral team a winning ring and an enjoyable day on 28th June.

Sue went on to explain the work of the RNLI and how brave volunteers have been saving lives at sea for over 200 years. How there are 238 lifeboat stations around the Uk and Ireland, which house 441 lifeboats and 7 hovercrafts.

She went on to tell us first hand stories from our rocky coastline, rough surf and riptides from our own coastal waters, talking about the crew that are bravely on call 24 hours a day, from Summerlease Beach in North Cornwall which result in many call outs.

Members were given a chance to try on some of the equipment that the crew wear.

She explained that volunteers raise awareness to try and keep people safe, she was now going into schools to educate children on water safety.

Of course, none of this is possible without our donations, for the boats, kit, and the training crews need to stay safe and save lives. The RNLI is a charity and is independent of the government.

She was thanked by Annie who felt that people need to know just how important it is to learn about the dangers of the sea and our coastline, and what to do in a situation.

Members are now looking forward to a visit to Bude Lifeboat station.

The winner of flower of the month was Gilian, with Doris winning the sea competition.

Members recently enjoyed a beautiful sunny walk with local historian Paul Rendell through the bluebell woods near Meldon, looking at the local history.

We recently held a very successful coffee morning and plant sale, also providing tea and cakes at the VE celebrations at Exbourne playing field.

Our June 10th meeting in the evening at Exbourne Hall, will be Neil and Kerry Littleales talking about the National open garden Scheme.



I have noticed over the last few weeks that I've been selling my tomato plants at Hatherleigh Market that there have been lots of people buying plants who are new to growing tomatoes. This article will just give a bit of basic advice to those who are new to growing (I don't want to teach any grandmas how to suck eggs.... or grow toms!) I mostly grow cordon toms which demand a little more attention but produce masses more fruit so this advice is for this type. The smaller the bushier the plant, the less tomatoes you will have. The bigger the tomato, the less you will have per plant but the weight of toms is standard so you choose whether you want lots of little ones or less big fat toms. 1. Make sure you buy a healthy plant that is green, well watered, strong, not stunted by being forced, not so big that it's pot-bound and definitely not one that is "all of the above" but has flowers on it.... that's wrong... very wrong! 2. If you are intending on growing your plants outside then try and find out from the grower if it has been hardened off, which means it is acclimatised to being outside; if they aren't acclimatised then the grower will advise you. If you are putting toms outside then they need a sheltered spot with plenty of sun and they really shouldn't go outside until the beginning of June. 3. Wherever you are putting your plant, get it in the ground, in a very big pot, a bed or a growbag as soon as possible. Just like a human in tight shoes, toms don't perform well if they are cramped. Toms don't have deep roots, they tend to spread out not far under the surface so planting them in something big and wide is better than tall and thin. 4. Cordon tomatoes will need to have a stake they can be loosely attached to with a piece of string for them to grow up. Put the stake in early so they can get growing without going wonky. As growbags aren't very deep you may need a tripod of stakes so the plant doesn't fall over. 5. while the plant is growing but before it produces many flowers, feed the plant with something like soluble Miracle Grow. ONLY use a preparatory tomato feed when the tomatoes are forming... tomato feed is designed for producing tomatoes and NOT the plant, which will go haywire and produce leaf if you start the tomato feed too early. I don't look at the instructions for either type of feed, I put a little bit (a tablespoon) in a very big feed bucket of water. Little and often is the key. 6. If left to its own devices a tomato plant will send out shoots from here, there and everywhere up the plant at each node between the leaves. You need to bend and pull off each of these little shoots or you will end up with a lovely green bush and very few tomatoes. You want one straight plant with leaves and flower stems, not a giant higgledy-piggledy triphid. 7. Each plant can support between 6 to 8 bunches of fruit before they get increasingly smaller so once you have 6-8 then cut off the top of the plant and keep cutting off any re-growth so the plant concentrates on making fruit. You can also remove some of the lower leaves to allow air circulation. If your plant is growing under cover then "tickle" the flowers with a gloved hand to aid pollination too; that way you get more fruit on each truss (bunch). 8. Feed and water.... feed and water..... keep pulling off the little bracts that grow and you WILL have some lovely toms. 9. Keep an eye out for any damage to the leaves that may be caused by aphids (you can usually spot these on the undersides of the leaves) wipe off the aphids or spray with a soapy solution as soon as you see them. 10. I know it sounds like a lot of pfaff but there is nothing better than fresh, juicy, flavoursome tomatoes straight from your own plant so give it a go!






