May day has been celebrated for around a thousand years, and more in other forms. The old party pooper puritans banned it all a good few centuries ago, but it came back in.





Our communities are fantastic. We should be proud of our voice. If you don't know how to be involved in local politics, ask around. If you do - maybe set a diary reminder to prompt yourself to write a letter, attend a meeting, volunteer, join a party. It may look like winter at times (from watching the news), but if we each plant some bulbs, and do some weeding, we'll have a bright future in the seasons coming. And of course, a huge thank you to everyone who already gives so much of themselves to just that.

Exbourne, Sampford Courtenay & Jacobstowe WI

Our President welcomed everyone, and introduced Angela Dodd-Compton, who gave a talk about The Italian Garden at Great Ambrook, a hidden garden that was discovered by accident near Ipplepen in 1988, and since then it has been uncovered to reveal an incredible garden.

Over the last 20 years Angela has been instrumental in finding out that the house of Great Ambrook and the 4 acre garden was owned by Arthur Smith-Graham who inherited a great wealth from his wealthy tea merchant family and bought the house and adjacent farm in 1899 at the age of 28, and commissioned TH Lyon to design the garden with Lewis Bearne building it, who also built Castle Drogo and Bovey Castle. Arthur Smith-Graham died in 1928 aged 56, who as a homosexual commissioned the garden as a secret retreat from society for his Oxbridge friends, leaving behind the beautiful Italian Garden, consisting of a tennis court, plunge pool, swimming pool, summer house and a hot house.

In the 1960's after the estate had been sold numerous times, the walled garden became forgotten, and overgrown.

It was down to Angela and through her work of discovery that the garden secured Grade II listed status with English Heritage. Members were left feeling totally immersed in the story of discovery that Angela told and thoroughly enjoyed her amazing voyage into the life of Arthur Smith-Graham.

Ten members enjoyed a visit to The Red Earth Group meeting hosted by Morchard Bishop WI, with a talk from wildlife photographer Stephen Powles, followed by a lovely supper.

Our Coffee and Cake morning, including a plant stall is organised for Saturday 10^{th} May at Exbourne Hall 10-12. Hopefully this will supported & enjoyed by everyone in the area.



We were delighted to be joined by so many supporters from Hatherleigh and elsewhere, and by visiting bellringers from other towers.





The Joy Of A Good Herb And Salad Garden

If you like cooking then a well stocked kitchen herb garden is essential to make your meals "zing" with flavour and, as in the picture, any container or pot will do and the closer it is to the kitchen door the better so you can just nip out and gather things instead of having to trapse down the garden or into the allotment.

I'm sorry but buying one tiny pot of any herb from the supermarket will not provide you with an endless supply, you need to grow in bulk and pot the plants up as they outgrow their pots or put them in a big container to start, perhaps alongside other plants that like the same conditions and then they will keep giving. Even good quality supermarket herbs will do well if you buy 3 or 4 at a time, take them out of their tiny pot and give them room to grow. I start growing my Basil from seed in April and those April plantings have their tips carefully harvested and they will be potted up and the same plants will keep providing me with fresh, green leaves until late August.

I grow all my herbs from seed or cuttings and I keep plants going by having enough of everything I love using like Parsley, Thyme, Dill, Chives, Oregano / Marjoram, Sage, Fennel, Coriander, Basil, Fenugreek, Rosemary, Lovage, Celery and Bay and all sorts of more unusual flavourings so I don't over-harvest any individual plant.

3 or 4 good small Basil, Thyme, Rosemary, Chives, Sage and Lovage plants can keep providing leaf all summer if they are planted in bigger pots or potted up as they grow and are well fed and watered and harvested by picking the top third instead of taking a pair of kitchen scissors to them (they don't like being grabbed and scissored!). Plants such as Coriander, Dill and Fenugreek will have a "shelf life" so you need to plant successions of them.

Don't forget that Rosemary, Thyme, Sage, Chives, Bay. Celery, Marjoram and Lovage are perennials so treat them with care and you will have them for years.

As part of your herb garden you can also keep pots of salad leaves going. I grow about 20-25 different salad leaves every year and there is always something to pick to go in with headed salad from the allotment but if you just want a few leaves to go in a sandwich then a pot or tub by the backdoor is ideal.

If you buy a bag of salad leaves and a bag of cut herbs every week then that can cost you £100 - £150 every year and let's face it, how many times have you bought a bagged herb or salad that's been chlorinated and / or filled with Co2 and you may use a little and when you return to it it's gone slimy and brown so you have to chuck it away (and it's plastic bag). It is far better to have fresh leaves with all their nutrients intact and you will grow to love your little herb / salad garden as the little plants keep growing and giving month after month.






