

Notes from the Council Meeting held on Tuesday 16th September 2025. The next Council meeting will be held on Tuesday 14th October at 7pm in the Community Centre. For more information see our website www.hatherleightowncouncil.org/

Your 9 Councillors are – Mark Reddaway (Chair/Mayor), Rachel Laycock (Deputy), Deb Laing- Trengove, Kay Walters, Donna Lewis, Richard Burrow, Sadie Harrison, Jake Barrs & Will Turner.

- We have one Councillor position vacant. If you would like to be considered for the position please express an interest to the Town Clerk in the first instance at the address at the bottom of the page.
- Mr Steve Whitehead has taken up his position as Street Caretaker and we wish to thank him for his excellent start. Having had a gap between Caretakers the difference is very apparent.
- 20 is Plenty: No volunteers from the Town have come forward to help with this scheme. Councillors can not do this alone this scheme will not be able to go ahead if there are no volunteers.
- School Entrance: Another meeting is due to take place on Thursday 25th September. This will be reported on in next month's notes.
- South Street will remain closed for the foreseeable future. A planning application is in place but we have no further information at present.
- Following a poor response from Ruby Country Medical Group to our previous letter voicing Patients concerns. We have written again asking for information. Our DCC Councillor Sue Davies has also written on our behalf., and the issue was raised with Mel Stride MP on his recent visit.
- The proposed axing of First Responders was also discussed with Mel Stride MP during his visit.
- The bench and area beside the Coop and bus stop is dangerous and needs urgent repair. We will ask WDBC to visit and suggest how this can be made safe for use.
- The new hanging baskets brackets have arrived and will be installed in the near future.
- The Challenge Tankard for the Best Hanging Basket as judged by the Open Gardeners was Awarded to Rachel Laycock. Runners-up were Beverley Agnew, Jane Fawcett and Katie Bennett. The Tankard was presented at the meeting by Mayor Mark Reddaway.
- The seesaw seats in Island Park are in urgent need of repair or replacement. We would ask that it not be used whilst this is organised.
- We have had 2 instances of people camping in the Cemetery and using it as a personal toilet. This is a Criminal Offence. The first incident was dealt with by the Police and the second was dealt with by Rev Leigh Winsbury. To whom we are very grateful. This is Consecrated ground and should be treated with respect. We will consider if new notices need to be installed to try to stop this happening. We would also like to remind Dog owners that all dogs must be on a lead in this area.
- We will write to WDBC to ask if a Pedestrian entrance can be added to the Town Car Park for safety.
- The Air Ambulance is unable to land on the side of the Football pitch at the moment as a landing bulb is broken. We will try to get this replaced as soon as possible.
- Hatherleigh Market: Trading has been good and events well attended. A 2nd toilet and the kitchen will be installed shortly. Music licences and alcohol licences have been applied for to open up the Market buildings use for many events. New bollards have been installed to protect the market square so it is available for trading. The Market Working Group are planning a Public Meeting on Saturday 27th September to explain the current position, future parking fee arrangements and the position re; Pledges. Tuckers Plot



Falafel

There are quite a few things still harvesting in the allotment and firm veg like butternut squash, beetroot and Carrots are great for Falafels.

These middle eastern patties are very easy to make and freeze really well to be reheated later. They are great in a pita bread with salad, coriander leaves, a dollop of yoghurt and a smear of chilli sauce or as an accompaniment with meat dishes and perhaps some sweetcorn.

You need:

a drained can of chickpeas

then equal volume of either butternut squash, beetroot or even carrot, swede, courgette.

2 crushed cloves of garlic

1 large egg beaten.

2 tbsp of chickpea flour sieved.

Mash everything up in the food processor then add

2 big handfuls of fresh breadcrumbs

Salt and black pepper

1 tsp cumin seeds

1 small handful of fresh mint finely chopped

(if you plan on having them with fish then substitute the mint for dill)

2 big handfuls each of fresh coriander and fresh parsley finely chopped

Squidge everything together in a bowl with your hand and shape into golf ball sized balls and then flatten them a bit as they fit in the pita easier then.

Let them firm up in the fridge for a while.

Shallow fry them for 7-8 mins, turning half way.


