# Happy October,

Autumn is well underway. According to an IPSOS survey last year, some 20% of us Brits feel this is our favourite season. So, perhaps you're relaxing into the home comforts, quieter evenings, rich earthy flavours of Autumnal foraging and the abundant beauty of bronzed forest floors. Or, maybe you're pining for next summer already!



Much of the world doesn't even have a distinct Autumn. Many nations move swiftly from dry to rainy seasons. It's an odd thought, when we have them every year, that millions have never experienced one!

Just like weather seasons differ geographically and personal preferences between them vary, so do the 'seasons' of our lives. You may know the saying, 'there's a season for everything'. When we talk of life's seasons, we tend to be consoling one another that things will get 'better', or that some things (like the weather) are beyond our control. These can be true and kind enough.

However, this use can pretend that we all experience the same seasons of life, or that our experience of similar events are the same. In truth, one parent may delight in the early years, another thrive in supporting their adult children, and many wish to be parents and cannot be for certain reasons; One career may begin easily enough and then fizzle out, whilst another takes decades of frustration to establish then flourishes fabulously. And, let's be honest, some things are caused by our own errors (and we can't blame the 'season').

The original saying of 'a season for everything' is from a book in the Bible called Ecclesiastes (chapter 3) and is actually a lot more sobering. The writer almost seems forlorn, describing how 'all is vanity' in life, and how all life ends as but' dust'. It teaches us that whilst it is prudent to

plan, it is foolish to find our self worth in our future hopes. To secure our joy on who we 'could' be, is simply not being at peace with who we are right now. Contentment, and enjoying whatever we have in any given 'season' is the key to a fulfilling and rich life. Not waiting for tomorrow, for "tomorrow has enough worries of it's own", as Jesus put it.

Where are you placing your hope this Autumn? Is it in hiding from, or holding onto the metaphorical summers past and winters to come? Perhaps as we stare into our freshly lit fires, and out of our increasingly drizzly windows, we might find space to give thanks for what we do have, and not what we want to have next. Maybe a season that appears to offer less externally, might offer us a chance to find more internally through grounding ourselves in a peace with ourselves, those closest to us, and God.

It's a big world out there to explore, but let's make sure we also explore our even bigger inner worlds, too. Peace be with you and those you love this Autumn,



# **Hatherleigh Bellringers**

It's likely there have been bells in Hatherleigh church since the 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> centuries CE. They would have been handbells, and the few examples that still exist are associated with the early Celtic Church; they were four-sided and of folded, riveted sheet metal, sometimes coated with bronze. The sound would have been more 'clonky', like a cow-bell. A purer ringing sound is achieved when the bell is cast in a mould and by the medieval period most churches would have had at least one bell, often cast on site by itinerant craftsmen who set up a temporary foundry in the churchyard. Bells were cast in bronze, an alloy of copper and tin.

There is no point in building a church tower unless there are to be bells in it, so the date of our tower may offer a clue to the date of Hatherleigh's first peal of bells. The archaeological report prepared after the spire fell in 1990 suggests that the stone tower was built some time in the late 1400s, with the wooden spire added in the later medieval period.

An inventory of church possessions in 1553 recorded three bells at Hatherleigh, but after that we don't have any information until the re-castings and bell additions made in 1813 and 1883.

In 1929, Hatherleigh's (apparently rather tuneless) eight bells were recast at Whitechapel Foundry in London, which created the fine tone and tuning we still enjoy today: the bells were not recast during the recent project to replace the frame. Now that everything is back in place and we can ring regularly, we need to maintain a healthy fund for repairs, or replacements of fittings and equipment. And that brings us neatly to our Christmas Bells Bingo.

We will hold our much-anticipated Bingo on 6<sup>th</sup> December and this year the bellringers would like to return some of the proceeds to the community who supported us so generously. We will be donating half of the profits to the Community Centre, where the event is being held.



# My Mum's Apple Cake

When I was little (so a long time ago!) mum's apple cake was always a favourite. It would be had slightly warm from the oven with ice-cream or hot custard and then cold the next day when it was easier to slice.

3 medium eating apples peeled, cored and thinly sliced

165g of caster sugar

125g of soft butter or cooking marg

1 tsp almond essence (or vanilla essence)

2 medium eggs beaten

225g self-raising flour

Approx 125ml full fat milk

Flaked almonds and a little more sugar for topping

NB ensure all ingredients are at room temperature



Cream butter, sugar and almond essence together and slowly add the beaten eggs and a small amount of the milk, then add the flour. The batter should be soft enough to eventually drop off your spoon if encouraged slightly; if it doesn't do this then add a bit more milk. You may not need the whole 125mls.

Preheat your oven to 160 degrees. Grease and line a 22cm spring-form tin. Put half your batter in and then a single layer of sliced apples. Add the rest of the batter and another layer of apples. Sprinkle with a little sugar and flaked almonds and cook in the middle of the oven for 40-45 mins. You may need to adjust timing, depending on your oven. Allow to cool a little in the tin for about 15-20 mins.






